<u>Shop with a Cop:</u> Officers take underprivileged children Christmas shopping for themselves and their families.

<u>Coffee with a Cop:</u> Brings police officers and community members together to discuss issues and learn more about each other.

<u>Citizen's Police Academy:</u> An educational program designed to open lines of communication between the community and police department by allowing citizens a firsthand look at the police department and how its operations are handled. In this program, citizens will take away a better understanding of the police role in the community while officers are able to learn and better understand the concerns of community members.

<u>Junior Police Academy:</u> Provides an opportunity for students and law enforcement officers to work to together in a fun, creative, and interactive way during the summer. The program will be designed in a way to introduce young people to law enforcement in the hope that they will consider a career in public safety, or to have an appreciation and respect for the role that police play in our communities.

<u>National Night Out:</u> Enhances the relationship between neighbors and law enforcement. Parents and children will have an opportunity to see squad cars, various emergency response vehicles, learn about a wide variety of topics and partake in numerous interactive family friendly activities.

<u>Various positive community engagement activities directed at kids:</u> For example, Pop-up events/block parties (food, entertainment, giveaways, educational information, etc).
