Excelsior Springs Police Department Community Outreach Unit provides various positive community engagement activities directed at kids such as Shop with a Cop and National Night Out.

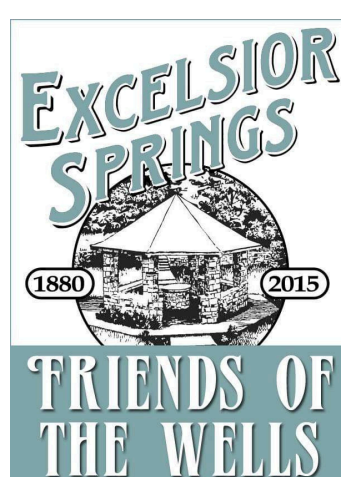
